NETWORKING EVENTS

PRE-INTERNSHIP SOCIAL NIGHT

Date: 19th January, 2024 (6 - 8pm AEDT)



NSWMSC will run an inaugural networking event for incoming interns and junior doctors across all the networks in NSW. It's a chance for imminent junior doctors to celebrate finishing medical school while networking with their future peers. This year we are also extending the invite to the classes of 2022 and 2021 as they have missed out in the past due to COVID-19.

This event will be a fantastic opportunity to speak to our final year students and junior doctors, just on the cusp of their blossoming career.



NSWMSC INTEGRATION CRUISE



Date: Mid April

With an aim to bring back inperson events in a COVID-safe manner, one of NSWMSC's mustgo events is a cruise cocktail. This is a fantastic opportunity for social networking between medical students across NSW/ACT.

Held in Sydney harbour, the NSWMSC cruise sold 500 tickets in less than 5 minutes in 2021 and almost 400 tickets in 2022. We expect the same success to continue in 2023 as students search for opportunities to meet their peers around the state.

STATE-WIDE SPORTS DAY

Date: June/July

To be held for the 6th time in 2023, the NSWMSC Sports Day continues to foster the medical student community spirit. With >100 attendees in 2019, Sports Day runs as a full day round robin tournament.





With the Sports Day Cup heavily contested, teams from all NSW and the ACT send their best and fairest, in a day of friendly competition. This year, pre-event social competitions that will drum up excitement and engagement will be run leading up to the day.

ACADEMIC EVENTS

RURAL HEALTH SYMPOSIUM

Date: September

The NSWMSC Rural Conference is a unique event, designed to provide education, upskilling and networking opportunities to those studying healthcare in rural NSW. This is the second year we will be running this event and we hope to build on the success of last years'. Students will get the opportunity to meet other healthcare professionals and develop an appreciation for their respective fields.
